In this very interactive workshop, Ms. Brown will present on the issues that come up in the parent child relationship when there has been exposure to domestic violence and how this shows up in care giver settings. She will also address the ways children can trigger each other in groups and how caregivers' own trauma background can potentially influence their ability to respond effectively. Through experiential exercises and activities, Ms. Brown will provide information and practical tools for working with children impacted by domestic violence in care-giving settings.

Leslie Brown is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker with experience in program development and providing direct services for children and families who have experienced domestic violence. She is a therapist and trainer in the Child-Parent Psychotherapy model of intervention developed by Alicia Lieberman and Patricia Van Horn using the manual "Don't Hit my Mommy". She has experience as a Montessori Preschool teacher and has supervised and developed programming for a therapeutic preschool and community based services. She has also worked as an Early Childhood Mental Health Consultant.
