Are you an LGBTIQA survivor of sexual abuse, sexual assault, or sexual harassment? You are not alone. Breaking through the silence can be powerful and healing. SASS groups provide peer emotional support in confidential and safe atmosphere that allows you to build trusting relationships while engaging in self-exploration and empowerment. Two SASS-trained facilitators co-facilitate each group.

As of November, 2011, SASS offers a weekly pre-screened, drop-in support group for LGBTIQA survivors of sexual violence.
